* **Set a Challenge WALT** – *CREATE AN ENVIRONMENT OF ENQUIRY AND WONDER.*

- *Aim to include a **challenge question** in your marking and feedback
- Intrinsic questioning: “How? What would happen if ? What is your interpretation of..? Can you defend ? What might happen next and why.? What can you now add ?
- **Home Learning:** Encourage ownership of learning and meaningful thinking that creates self direction. Use triggers. Open ended questions with word limits. Variety of questions / tasks. Less can be more.
